- ❖ **EACO’s** Board of Directors passed the following resolution at their May 2009 meeting: May 28, 2009 -

*“The Board of EACO wishes by this unanimous resolution of our members (who represent the majority of the hazardous materials consultant, union and non-union contractors) to present this input to the Steering Committee.*

*Based on our cumulative experience of the implementation of 253W and 253S (Asbestos Abatement Worker and Supervisor Certification), we are concerned with the suggested duration and content of the Hazardous Material Worker training suggested by the Sub-Committee; that it is of excessive duration and includes components not of value and beyond the original intent of the Hazardous Worker Certification.*

*Our representatives have our full support in their position and will clarify the intent of this resolution to the Steering Committee.”* Stay tuned for further updates as they become available.
